Common types of IPR are trademarks (which serve to differentiate products or services and enable informed purchasing decisions), industrial designs (which promote innovation by protecting the visual appearance of (parts of) products, or their ornamentation) and patents (which reward technological innovation).

The intrinsic value of IPR combined with a supportive IP system boosts the inventiveness that drives progress.

During this year's IPR Conference, specialists from both the public and the private sectors will discuss innovative IP ecosystems, green technology solutions and technology partnerships, jointly addressing IP's potential to help realize plans for a sustainable, greener future.

The IPR Conference is co-hosted by the European Chamber of Commerce in Korea (ECCK), the European Patent Office (EPO), the Global Green Growth Institute (GGGI) and the Korea Intellectual Property Office (KIPO).
