" Korea is a success story as regards maritime transport, both as provider of maritime business and transport services, as well as a highly connected country within the global liner shipping network. The presentation will provide key data about the Maritime Country Profile of the country, and latest trends about shipping connectivity of Korea's seaports. As regards the future, the presentation will focus on two key challenges. First, there is the challenge of digitalization. Covid-19 has led to a further push towards the modernization and dematerialization of processes. We need to lock-in the progress made during lock-down. The trade facilitation solutions that we are promoting help achieve both: facilitate trade and its transport, and at the same time protect transport workers, officials, and the population. As regards decarbonization in shipping, there are new and novel proposals being made towards market-based measures, such as a levy, or contribution carbon. The presentation will provide some updates and latest trends on carbon emissions from shipping, building on recent UNCTAD work in collaboration with the IMO."
