ECCK Live Webinar on Certain Upcoming Corporate Reforms and Partial Amendments to the Korean Commercial Code

On June 11, 2020, the Ministry of Justice pre-announced a proposed partial amendment to the Korean Commercial Code that aims to improve corporate governance by introducing a multi-level derivative lawsuit system, a separate election for audit committee members, and enhanced rights for minority shareholders, among other changes (the "Bill"). The Bill was approved by the Cabinet and soon thereafter submitted to the National Assembly on August 31, 2020; and is currently pending review before the Legislation and Judiciary Committee. We recommend that companies closely monitor future legislative developments regarding this matter, as the Bill is generally expected to pass during an upcoming plenary session. During the webinar, two corporate partners from Bae Kim & Lee's Corporate Practice Group will provide an overview of the key features and implications of the Bill, followed by a Q&A session.
