Global Management

This curriculum focuses on cultivating managerial perspectives and mindsets to predict the global management trends and the formulate effective business strategies.

Business Design

This curriculum provides opportunities to acquire specialized knowledge in technology, design, and marketing, with a particular emphasis on fostering efficient communication among departments. Through in-depth projects, students gain expertise in marketing techniques and develop competitive products and brands.

Entrepreneurship, Start-up

To thrive in the era of global low-growth, this program nurtures an entrepreneurial mindset and develops capabilities to generate new sources of growth. Students gain insights from successful Finish startup cases and their processes.

Digital Transformation

This program prepares students for the evolving business environment created by the remarkable innovations in digital technologies such as mobile, cloud, big data, artificial intelligence (AI), Internet of Things (IoT), and robotics. It equips students with the essential skills to navigate and leverage digital advancements in various aspects of business management, customer relations, and business processes.

The Aalto Track, available within the Helsinki Residence Program (HRP), allows students to select and apply for their preferred track upon admission. However, it is possible to request a track change after the start of the semester. Each track's classes are offered with the requirement of a minimum enrollment of 20 students or more, in accordance with the regulations of internationally recognized accreditations such as AACSB(Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business), AMBA(Association of MBAs), EQUIS (European Quality Improvement System)

- Applicants with a regular 4-year bachelor's degree from accredited domestic or international universities, or with equivalent qualifications as defined by relevant regulations.
 - * Including individuals who have obtained a bachelor's degree through institutions such as open universities, cyber universities, and credit banks.
- Applicants with more than 5 years of work experience (including military service, NGO activities, and self-employment).
 * <u>Required to submit the references related to work experience.</u>
